Title: Supplemental Teacher

**Organizational Relationships:** Evaluated by the Principal, or other appropriately certificated administrators/supervisors as designated by the superintendent.

**Primary Function:** Assume responsibility for instruction of assigned students in accordance with district, school, program goals. Objectives and standards as approved by the Board of Education

## **Major Responsibilities:**

- 1. Provide academic support for students in their regular education subjects.
- 2. Implement the Individualized Education Program (IEP) for assigned students in consultation with Supervisors of Special Education.
- 3. Confer with cooperating classroom teachers regarding student's progress.
- 4. Write required components of IEP for assigned students (including but not limited to, Strengths, PLAAFPs, Areas of Need, Goals and Objectives).
- 5. Consult with IEP team as needed for other components of the IEP
- 6. Attend IEP meetings when assigned
- 7. Maintain records of student performance.
- 8. Contact parents regarding student progress under the direction of the supervisor or case manager.

## Qualifications:

- 1. Holds or is eligible for New Jersey instructional certificate with appropriate teaching endorsement (Subject area certificate, TOH, or TOSD).
- 2. Such additions to the above qualifications as the Board may find appropriate and acceptable.

Term of Employment: Ten-month year, in accordance with contractual arrangements as approved by the Board of Education.

Evaluation: According to State Statutes, *N.J.A.C. Title 6*, Board Policy and Procedures.
