Dear Parents/Guardians:

On Tuesday, September 6th, we became aware of a mold situation in the television studio at Ramapo High School. An environmental consultant was called in and performed air and surface sampling. Based on the results of those samples, that suite of rooms was closed off and the entire wing of the building was sampled as a precautionary measure.

Results confirmed that mold was present in both the air and surface sampling of the television studio; however, air quality in the remainder of the suite was not

compromised even though surface tests detected mold spores. That suite has been closed. Adjacent rooms have been cleared and students have been permitted access.

Remediation of the space will commence shortly and will be conducted in accordance with industry standards based on a scope of work that was prepared by an Industrial Hygienist who specializes in these types of situations. It is anticipated that the television studio will be closed for the next month.

Arrangements are being made to provide an alternate location for the education of the students who would normally use that area.
